PURPOSE:

The purpose of this meeting was to:

- Establish the necessity of repair to the water headgates in Jardine Park and to grant Mayor Thomas authority to make such expenditures as necessary to complete the Child-Pedestrian Walking Path.


EXAMINATION OF WATER HEADGATES IN JARDINE PARK AND PROPOSED SOLUTIONS:

- It was noted that the pipe moving water through the park has been damaged and needs repair in order to facilitate and complete construction on the Child-Pedestrian walkway that is in process of construction.
- There are other obstructions that have been identified or which may occur that will need to be remedied also.
- Celena moved that Mayor Thomas be permitted to authorize projects necessary to repair irrigation problems and any other incidents occurring, including the removal of a tree, in order to finish the child-pedestrian walking path with expenditures up to the maximum amount of the grant of \$250,000. Roll call vote was taken: Celena, yes; Waco, yes; Brigham, yes. Motion passed.
