

MINUTES
CITY OF LEWISVILLE REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING
Wednesday, August 12, 2026
Lewisville Community Center, 3451 E 480 N, Lewisville, Idaho.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Fred Tucker at 7:14 p.m. at the Lewisville Community Center at 3451 E 480 N, Lewisville, Idaho. Present were Mayor Fred Tucker, Council Members Waco Taylor, Celena Lewis and Brigham Briggs (by phone); Clerk/Treasurer Connie Olsen; Officer Mike Miller from the Jefferson County Sheriff's Department; residents and non-residents. Kris Meek was the representing Attorney present.

Pledge of Allegiance – Celena

Celena amended the agenda to move to accept the minutes at the beginning of the meeting. Waco second the motion. Motion passed.

- Celena moved to accept minutes of special sessions and regular session for August 2026. Waco second the motion. Motion passed.

Celena moved to have the Police report to the next item on the agenda. Waco second the motion. Motion passed.

POLICE REPORT – Mike Miller

- Mike Miller went over the Jefferson County Sheriff's Report from 6-20-2026 to 7-17-2026. The sheriff's office logged 160 hours with 14 incidents, 0 arrests, 0 DUI, 3 citations and 15 traffic contacts. There was a traffic accident, a few animal complaints, some fireworks complaints, custody issues, property damage (a window broke out of the car not a recent report but they don't know when it happened)

PUBLIC HEARING ON FY 2027 BUDGET

- The Mayor opened the public hearing for the FY 2027 Budget. The clerk presented the budget. The Mayor opened the floor for public input, both pro, negative and neutral. There was no discussion so the Mayor called for a motion to close the hearing. Celena moved that the budget hearing for FY 2027 close, Waco second the motion to close the session. Roll call was taken Brigham, yes; Waco, yes and Celena, yes. Motion passed.
- Brigham moved to waive reading the 2026-2027 Annual Appropriation Ordinance 2026 three times and read summary only once. Celena second the motion to skip reading 3 times and read the ordinance summary once. The Mayor read summary. Celena moved to accept the 2026-2027 Annual Appropriations Ordinance 2026-3. Waco second the motion to accept. Roll call vote was called. The following votes were: Brigham, yes, Waco, yes and Celena, yes. Motion Passed.

- Celena table Resolution 2026-2 The Idaho Transportation Department, hereafter called the State, has submitted an Agreement stating obligation of the STATE and the City of Lewisville, hereafter called the city, for construction of 500 North between 3400 East (Lewisville HWY) and 3500 East (State HWY 48). Until city attorney can review the contract and resolution. Waco second motion to table. Motion was tabled.

CLERK/TREASURER – Connie Olsen

- Celena moved to pay the bills from July 9 to Aug 12, 2026 be paid. Brigham seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- The Clerk reminded the city that the sign grant needs to be completed. Maintenance needs to purchase signs as soon as possible. The grant has to be closed out by October 1, 2026.

MAYOR REQUEST – Fred Tucker

- The Cotton Wood Trees need to address these trees to avoid mitigation. We will be getting to cut trees, going to survey trees in the city. We will address the worst trees first and then get on an annual schedule to maintain the trees in the city. The city will go to the citizen and ask them to pay their portion if the tree is on the city and owners property.
- The Mayor will sign the proclamation September 17 -23, 2026 Proclamation to establish Constitution Week. Kris has a replica of the constitution that he will bring and have the DAR come to the next meeting so they can be here for the proclamation signing.
- Kris didn't have changes to the substance of ordinance for Ordinance 2026-4. Have Kris's approval Special Meeting August 26, 2026 at 6:00 pm to vote on Ordinance 2026-4 because it had to run twice, 15 days before the meeting.

ROADS – Waco

- We need to get the plow truck sold and get something to replace it before the snow comes. They will be tearing up and paving the road sometime the end of August or first of September.

PLANNING AND ZONING – Brigham

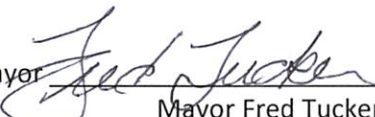
