- Celena moved to accept the meeting minutes. Waco second the motion. Motion passed

**POLICE REPORT – Mike Miller**

- Mike Miller went over the Jefferson County Sheriff's Report from 03-28-26 to 4-24-26. The sheriff's office logged 103 hours with 13 incidents, 0 arrests, 0 DUI, 4 citations and 21 traffic contacts. Officer Miller said it was a pretty quiet month in Lewisville. There were 8 control burn calls, 2 property damage, a breaking into property and a traffic stop.

**Nuveck & Twisted Technology**

- IT presentation \$325 manage network & firework/month. Access point needs to be replaced at the library also. Nuveck is working the on the iPads so that they are accessible. When the prior council used them they put their personal iPod information on them and we can't unlock them. We may be able to if the clerk can find the receipts.
- Camera system is old and needs to be updated. It was installed in 2020. The clerk's office camera needs replace and we should put one out front, the point to point would be changed, switch proposal for next needs. New system in and replace camera as they file. A motion notification camera would be installed at the building so someone is aware of disturbances. Chief Fulmer is looking for Money have they found grants. Bryce ran cable added emergency

#### **MAYOR REQUEST – Fred Tucker**

- The BRIC FY 2024-25 Program was rejected.
- Councilwoman secured a first aid kit for the community center and shop. The Mayor will order defibrillator and have it installed.
- Jefferson County Planning & Zoning Ordinance will be discussed at the next council meeting, along with the Door to Door Solicitations Ordinance. Celena will make changes and send to Kris to review.
- Eric Olsen was introduced as a new member of the maintenance crew.

#### **ROADS - Waco**

Waco reported that the mower deck was purchased and delivered to the shop. They will start mowing this next weekend. David said that he had been out in the city and sprayed weeds with a yard mix spray. They will begin spraying mosquitos as the need arises.

#### **PLANNING AND ZONING - Brigham**

- Sam Cook presented a building permit application 488 N 3435 E, Lewisville. He is going to move a single wide manufactured home onto a permanent foundation. Will install septic and well. Council reviewed paperwork. He meets all requirements. The entrance to the property will come in the Southside for the drive through. He wants to move the home in as soon as possible. Celena moved that we accept the proposal, Brigham second the motion. Motion passed.

#### **COMMUNITY**


- The young man responsible for the social media site got another job. He found that there is a security issue and he is only able to sign up for one account – he wants to send a flier that allows patterns to send a link to sign up for notifications from the city and work with John Walker to put city stuff on the community Facebook page.
- John Walker talked about the 250<sup>th</sup> Celebration/founders day celebration to be held July 25, 2026. He said that there are some great ideas on the 250 website. We could get stuff for the block party. They have lots of ideas and helps on the website. They will be serving hamburgers, hot dogs, corn on the cob, have a soda truck, snow cones and popcorn. The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints will provide the food if the city could help with some of the activities. The community center will be reserved for July 24 & 25 for community party.
- We are going to check into shuttling people from Lewisville to Menan for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July talk to committee for 4<sup>th</sup> of July. Mayor Tucker will talk to the Mayor and check on a charter bus.
- There were approximately 170-180 people at the Easter Egg Hunt. They will get receipts to the clerk.

#### **OTHER**

- Mayor Tucker has volunteer that is willing to install stairs into the attic. He will put the stairs in, if we buy the material. Waco will get it measured and check on moving the light. Mayor Tucker has also found someone to put up and take down the wreath at Christmas.
- Celena & Brigham will not be here next month. Brigham said he would be available by phone. Blake said he will be absent in July.
