### AREA OF IMPACT AGREEMENT WITH JEFFERSON COUNTY:

- The Council discussed possible boundary changes to the current area of impact which could
  extend to 300 North and what that would mean for the City. They reviewed the rough legal
  description and determined that a more definitive description would be needed to submit with
  the AOI to Jefferson County. Forsgren will work on this description for Exhibit B and create a
  map for Exhibit A. Mayor Thomas will create a rough map and send it to Forsgren to work from.
- They reviewed the draft of Exhibit C and made changes as they felt necessary.
- A public hearing on the AOI will be set for the April 13, 2022 City Council meeting.

#### SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE:

 Kort Ware presented a draft of development fees that could be added to the subdivision ordinance that would cover expenses of the City for engineering and in processing the paperwork and the expense of a public hearing. Modifications were made to the proposal.
