

MINUTES  
**Special City of Lewisville City Council Meeting**  
June 23, 2021

Meeting was called to order by Mayor George Judd at 7:09 p.m. at the Lewisville Community Center at 3451 E 480 N, Lewisville, Idaho. Present were Mayor George Judd; Council Members, James Ball, Brigham Briggs, Mark Williamson and Linda Linsenmann; Clerk/Treasurer, Donetta Fife and one resident.

The meeting had been scheduled by the Council during the regular City Council meeting on June 9, 2021 for the purpose of:

- Considering options for an amendment to Lewisville Code 8-5-8 – Animals in Residential and Commercial Zones and for drafting a Bill to present to the public at a public hearing and to set the time date and time of the public hearing.
- Discussing and formulating a list of pros and cons to the ceding of 16.5 feet of Lewisville right of way to adjacent residents on particular streets.

The Council considered the R-1 residential zoning for the City and considered how best to maintain the residents' rights to have livestock and small domestic animals for personal use while also protecting the rights of neighboring properties. After much consideration the Council agreed upon a draft which will be presented to the attorney for review.


The public hearing on the Code change was set for July 14, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. Donetta will publish notice in the paper as required and will post the proposed Bill to the City website so residents can review it prior to the meeting.

The Council then discussed the pros and cons of ceding 16.5 feet of Lewisville right of way to adjacent residents on particular streets. A list of pros and cons was formulated. A public hearing on the matter was set for July 14, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. or immediately following the hearing on the animal ordinance. Donetta was instructed to publish the Notice of Public Hearing and to mail a copy of the pros and cons to residents of the City prior to the hearing.

James moved that the meeting be adjourned at 9:44 p.m., Brigham seconded, motion passed.
