BUILDING PERMIT:

- Mark Fletcher proposed a change of house plan for his home in Countryside Meadows
 Subdivision. The setback and placement will remain the same as the original plan. The new plan
 will need to be submitted to the Department of Building Safety for approval. A new fee will be
 charged after he determines the cost of the structure.
- The Clerk asked if he could give a ballpark figure for construction of the new library addition based on square footage. Donetta will forward plans to him for evaluation.

PEDESTRIAN SAFE PATHWAY GRANT:

• The City has been approved for a grant for the Child Protection and Pedestrian Safety Grant that was applied for in 2022. The grant was originally rejected as Lewisville was below the cutoff for funding. With new funds through the State of Idaho, the grant can now be funded. The Council discussed the possibility of changing the path of the original plan. Brigham will meet with a committee of citizens next week to discuss the possibilities. The item will be placed on the Agenda for June for citizen input and will be posted to notify citizens of the discussion.

SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE:

• The development fee connected to the Subdivision Ordinance was discussed. Kort will revise the schedule to be presented at the June City Council. Donetta will send a copy of the current draft of the Subdivision Ordinance to the Council for input.

CODE REVISIONS:

• Council Members will review the Code and identify items that need to be revised.
