

ORDINANCE 2018-5

AMENDMENT TO LEWISVILLE CITY CODE

TITLE 4 CHAPTER 1 SUBSECTION 2

AN AMENDMENT TO THE CITY CODE OF LEWISVILLE, IDAHO, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, TITLE 4, CHAPTER 1, SUBSECTION 2 ALLOWING REMOVAL OF ILLEGALLY STORED AUTOMOBILES, AUTOMOBILE PARTS AND JUNKED MACHINERY AT OWNER'S EXPENSE SEVEN DAYS AFTER A NOTICE IS POSTED ON SUCH ITEM

WHEREAS, the City Code of Lewisville, Idaho states that any automobile body that is not licensed with current registration or is not in operating condition, and any stripped, dismantled or junked machinery, automobile, automobile body, stripped, dismantled or junk machinery may not be stored on City rights of way, highways, or other public property; and

WHEREAS, the City Code does not identify unlicensed and/or non-operating vehicles or machinery that cannot be stored on City rights of way, highways, or other public property, and

WHEREAS, it would improve the appearance of the City of Lewisville if unlicensed and/or non-operating machinery were also stored on private land and not on City rights of way, highways, or other public property, and

WHEREAS, the Code does not provide for the removal of the above-described automobiles, parts or machinery, and

WHEREAS, it would make the Code more enforceable if a removal clause were added to make removal expense the obligation of the property owner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, IDAHO

That Title 4, Section 1, Subsection 2 of the City Code of Lewisville, Idaho shall be amended and shall read as follows:

4-1-2: Storage of Automobiles and Machinery:

Any automobile, ~~or~~ automobile body, vehicle or item of machinery that is not licensed with current registration or is not in operating condition, and any stripped, dismantled or junked machinery, automobile, automobile body, or parts may not be parked, stored or maintained upon any roads, streets, sidewalks, city rights of way, highways, or other public property; and none of the items described above may be parked, stored, or maintained on any private premises unless stored or maintained behind the building setback line and concealed from public view by landscaping, fences, garages, outbuildings, or other methods. A violation notice shall be posted on all such items located on any roads, streets, sidewalks, city rights of way, highways, or other public property and such item(s) shall be towed or otherwise removed by the City at owner's expense seven (7) days after the violation notice is posted on such item(s).
